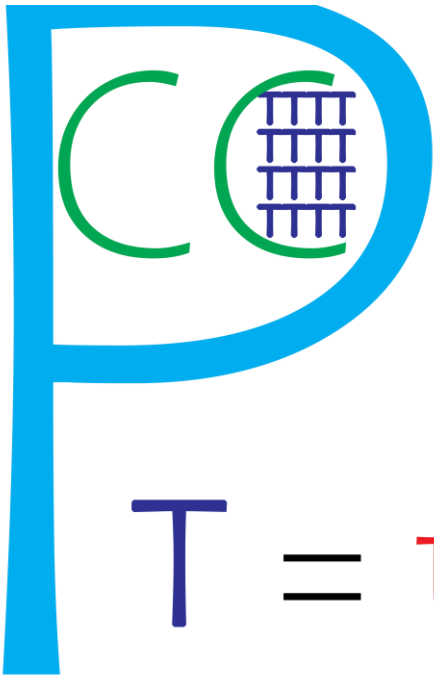
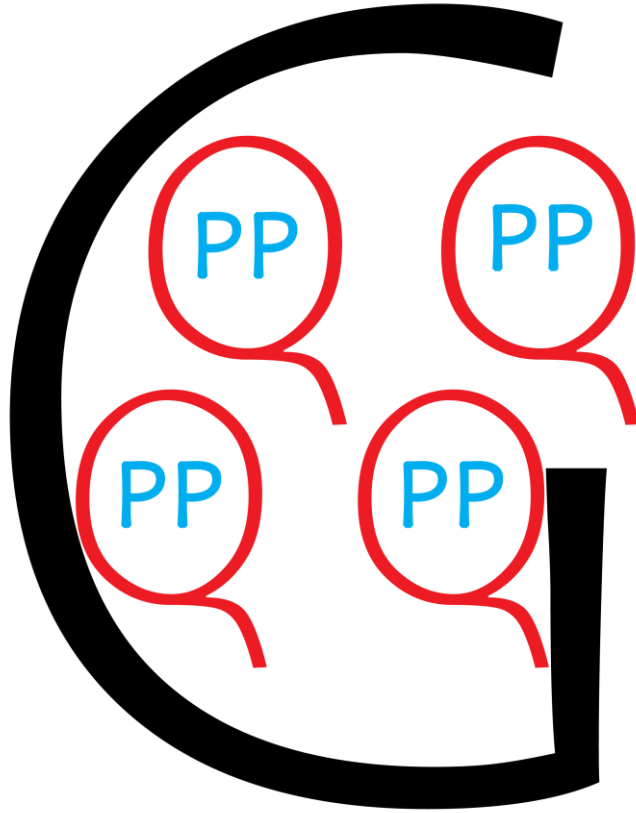


# Measurement Conversion

## Easy Reference Chart

1 Gallon = 4 Quarts

1 Quart = 2 Pints



1 Pint = 2 Cups

1 Cup = 16 Tablespoons

1 Tablespoon = 3 Teaspoons

$$T = t \times 3$$

# Common Abbreviations:

Gallon - gal.

Quart – qt.

Pint – pt.

Cup - c

Tablespoon - TB, Tb *or* T

Teaspoon – tsp *or* t

Ounce – oz.

Pound – lb.

Milliliter – ml

Liter – l

Gram – g

Kilogram – kg

Dozen – doz.

Hour – hr.

Minute – min.

# Practice

If there are 3 teaspoons in a Tablespoon...

And 16 Tablespoons in a cup...

And 2 cups in a pint...

Then  $3 \times 16 \times 2 = 96$  teaspoons in a pint

Using the chart and example above, answer the following questions:

How many pints are in 3 gallons?

How many teaspoons are in 2 cups?

How many cups are in a quart?

*Answers: 24 pints, 96 teaspoons, 4 cups*
